C4H Bridging the Gap between Poverty & Transportation

Transportation is critical to nearly every component of daily life. It enhances both physical and economic mobility and is a key factor in workers ability to find and retain employment. Employment requires mobility. Workers need transportation to jobs and child care centers and other services that make work possible. Unreliable transportation can have grave consequences for the working poor, including added expenses for chronic car repairs or late fees for child care, lower earnings due to delays getting to work, and possibly job loss.

Working in collaboration with many area nonprofits, Chariots4Hope (C4H) restores donated cars that meet our quality standards and award them to eligible low-income families, who are referred to us by community partners. The cars that are non-repairable due to the nature of the damage are sold and all proceeds go towards supporting the mission. So far in 2017, Chariots4Hope awarded over 35 vehicles to low-income families in the Omaha community. Between donations to Chariots, and the number of nonprofits expressing interest, it's anticipated that 2 times as many automobiles might be disbursed this in 2018.

C4H Tax Advantage

More than 99% of U.S. charities use donated cars for revenue only. C4H car donors gain a tax advantage since we award donated vehicles to families in need. Because that's our mission, IRS regulations allow many C4H donors to claim the full fair market value of their car—the maximum permitted by law.

C4H afterCARE PROGRAM

All of our vehicles are donated "as is" with no warranty to our recipients. A quality multi-point inspection is conducted and every vehicle is brought up to safety standards. However, our inspections still do not guarantee a problem free vehicle, especially since most of our donated cars are older models with high mileage.

Our afterCARE program focuses on creating a plan that will provide long term assistance for all of our recipients transportation needs. This program provides six educational classes that focus on sustainability planning and resource development, basic car maintenance, and a mentorship program. Our afterCARE program adds an extra level of accountability that helps prevent individuals from returning to old habits that kept them away from self-sufficiency.

AfterCARE Requirements

- Must complete 6 mandatory classes and 1 elective for a total of 7 classes.
- Must attend a minimum of 1 class per month in the following order
- Monthly meetings with Case Manager
- If you miss a class then your warranty becomes inactive until you make the class up
- Complete a monthly budget
- Participate in an income-based savings plan
- Be in good standing with your Referring Organization
- Provide proof each month that insurance is current
